Date Minister's Request Received: 09-10-2018

Change/s requested:

Alcoa of Australia have requested changes to conditions 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 of Ministerial Statement 728 and 1069 in order to facilitate an increase in production to 3.3 million tonnes per annum (Mtpa).

Preliminary Factors relevant to the requested change/s:

Air Quality, Social Surroundings, Inland Waters

Determination:

Section 46 – Request for a change to Environmental Conditions.

Explanation of decision:

Request from the Minister for Environment to EPA to inquire into changing implementation conditions relating to a proposed increase in production to 3.3 Mtpa, without triggering the upper limit expansion of 4.7 Mtpa.

Rights of Appeal:

There are no rights of appeal under the EP Act in respect of this decision.
