Potential significant effects:

Clearing of 3, 690 ha native vegetation which is also terrestrial fauna habitat; direct and indirect impacts conservation significant vegetation and flora; direct and indirect impacts on conservation significant fauna and habitat; groundwater abstraction for water supply resulting in groundwater drawdown; modifications to existing catchments and associated impacts to flow paths of surface water streamflows such as intermittent pools; and potential impacts to Aboriginal heritage values and Karijini National Park.

Preliminary key environmental factors:

Flora and Vegetation, Terrestrial Fauna, Hydrological Processes, Inland Waters Environmental Quality and Social Surroundings.
