Potential significant effects:

The mine expansion involves an increase of the mine and infrastructure footprints, and clearing of up to 7,119.5 ha of native vegetation and fauna habitat. The proposal requires disturbance to the banks of the Hotham River for the development of two haul road crossings. The proposed mining and related activities also has the potential for increased noise, dust, greenhouse gases, vehicle movements and adverse impact on amenity.

Preliminary key environmental factors: Flora and Vegetation, Terrestrial Fauna, Terrestrial Environmental Quality, Inland Waters, Social Surroundings and Air Quality.
