Referral examined, preliminary investigations and inquiries conducted. Proposal not to be assessed under Part IV of the EP Act – No advice given.

Explanation of decision:

The EPA considers that the likely environmental effects of the proposal are not so significant as to warrant formal assessment because the majority of the development envelope is previously cleared; sand and clay extraction will be above groundwater and there will be a buffer to water courses; and impacts on amenity can meet appropriate standards such as compliance with the Environmental Protection (Noise) Regulations 1997.

It is noted that other statutory processes relevant to this proposal include Part V Division 2 (Clearing) of the Environmental Protection Act 1986, permit under section 17 of the Rights in Water and Irrigation Act 1914 and Local Government Development Approval under the Planning and Development Act 2005.

This decision is appealable. Appeals close 16-09-2019. Appeals are Appeals: administered by the Office of the Appeals Convenor.
