Environmental Quality

Potential Significant Effects: Clearing of remnant vegetation to create building envelopes, for

bushfire protection and for fencing/firebreaks. Possible emissions impacts

from an adjacent small scale market garden. Possible groundwater

quality impacts due to effluent treatment.

Management: The potential impacts can be adequately managed to meet the EPA's objectives through the implementation of the City of Albany's scheme provisions, commitments and management plan/s, and regulated through other statutory processes.

Potential impacts from market garden activities directly to the north of the amendment area can be dealt with by the City of Albany's proposed scheme provisions to ensure appropriate setbacks.

Determination: Referral Examined, Preliminary Investigations and Inquiries Conducted. Scheme Amendment Not to be Assessed Under Part IV of EP Act. No Advice Given. (Not Appealable)
