This proposal may be implemented subject to the following conditions:

- The proponent adhering to the proposal as assessed by the Environmental Protection Authority and fulfilling the commitments made for environmental management (copy of the commitments attached).
- The proponent shall ensure that the container storage operations are undertaken with minimum noise generation and to the requirements of the Environmental Protection Authority. Any proposal to operate outside stipulated times (as a result of an emergency) shall be only undertaken with the specific approval of the Environmental Protection Authority.
- 3. Prior to the transfer of ownership of the project from the proponent to another party, the proponent shall advise the other party of the conditions and commitments applicable to the project; and the other party shall advise the Minister for Environment, in writing, of its acceptance of those conditions.
