SHIRE OF DENMARK TOWN PLANNING SCHEME NO. 3 AMENDMENT NO. 24

Scheme Purpose:

- a) to rezone Part Reserve 34209, Reserves 25961 and 25348 and Lot 953, bounded by Peace Street, Hardy Street and South Coast Highway, from the Public Use reserve to the Residential zone with an R20 density coding;
- b) to transfer Part Reserve 34209 from the Public Use reserve to the Parks and Recreation reserve;
- c) to rezone Part Reserve 35774 South Coast Highway from the Parks and Recreation reserve to the Residential zone with an R20 density coding; and
- d) to rezone Reserve 42271 Teesdale Street from the Public Use reserve to the Parks and Recreation reserve.
