The implementation of this proposal to which the above reports of the Environmental Protection Authority relate is subject to the conditions and procedures contained in Ministerial Statement No. 382 (13 March 1995), as amended by the following:

*Condition 2-1 (Target Loads for Nitrogen and Phosphorus) of Statement No. 382 is deleted and the following condition is inserted:*

- 2-1 The proponent shall not permit the combined mean monthly nutrient loadings within both the original and second pipelines from the Beenyp Wastewater Treatment Plant to exceed 1500 kilogrammes per day plus 10 per cent for total phosphorus, and 3.6 tonnes per day for total nitrogen.
