The implementation of the proposal to which the above reports of the Environmental Protection Authority relate is subject to the conditions and procedures contained in Ministerial Statement No. 399 (amended by Statement No.825), as amended by the replacement of Condition 4-4 with the following:

4-4 Notwithstanding Conditions 4-2 and 4-3, a single flight departure is allowed between 2200 hours on 20 February 2011 and 0100 hours on 21 February 2011. The maximum noise level associated with this flight shall not exceed 80 dB LA_{Slow} when measured within 15 metres of a building that is directly associated with a noise-sensitive use on a noise-sensitive premises, in accordance with Part 3 of the Environmental Protection (Noise) Regulations 1997.
