Ministerial Statement 1085, issued 26 October 2018

DECISION

Pursuant to s. 45C(5) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act), and as delegate for the Minister for Environment, I give approval to the following amendments of the approved proposal:

- Administrative change to correct a misdescription to and to the format of implementation condition 8 in Ministerial Statement 1085 that does not alter the obligations of the proponent.

SUMMARY OF REASONS

- This amendment to correct a misdescription of any person, thing or property and make an administrative change to the format of an implementation condition that does not alter the obligations of the proponent, is within the definition of s. 45C(5) of the EP Act.
- There are no new environmental factors likely to be significantly affected as a result of the amendment.
- The effects of the amendment on their own, the effect of the amendment in the context of the existing referred proposal, cumulative impacts, and holistic impacts have been considered.
- The amended proposal will be substantially the same character as the existing referred proposal.
