DECISION

Pursuant to s. 45C(5) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act), the Chair acting as delegate for the Minister for the Environment gives approval to the following amendments of the approved conditions:

- Administrative change in the development envelope and disturbance footprint extents of condition 1-1.

SUMMARY OF REASONS

- The change to condition 1-1 is considered administrative as it is to correct a clerical error. The amendment corrects an error which inadvertently increased the total disturbance footprint in Condition 1-1, rather than the development envelope area.
- There are no new environmental factors likely to be significantly affected as a result of the amendments.

EFFECT OF THIS NOTICE:

1. The proposal as amended in accordance with this notice is taken to be able to be implemented under s. 45 of the EP Act.

RIGHTS OF APPEAL:

There are no rights of appeal under the EP Act in respect of this decision.
