MINISTERIAL STATEMENT AND ANY APPROVED CHANGES

Ministerial Statement 633 (MS633) was issued 5 September 2003 and a change to approved proposal 3 December 2004 and further amended 22 December 2008 (Attachment 1), 23 September 2010 (Attachment 2), 12 August 2014 (Attachment 3), 23 May 2019 (Attachment 4) and 4 March 2025 (Attachment 5).

DECISION

Pursuant to s. 45C (4) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act), the Chair acting as delegate for the Minister for Environment gives approval to the following amendments of the approved proposal and implementation conditions:

- Inclusion of the authorised extent of disturbance for Processing and Infrastructure in the Southern Mines and Development Envelope in Table 2 of the Ministerial Statement.
- Removal of reference to a windfarm within Processing and Infrastructure areas in Table 2
- Amendment of a spelling error in the short proposal description of Table 1.

The amended proposal content document and figures are attached.

SUMMARY OF REASONS

- Changes to MS633 to rectify minor clerical errors arising from a system error that affected edits made to the web version of the document being saved.
- The error resulted in:
 - The omission of the authorised extent of disturbance as stated in Table
 Location and authorised extent of physical and operational elements.
 - Mention of 'windfarm infrastructure' under Processing and infrastructure that was not approved by the s.45C application.
- These errors do not reflect a substantial material change to the approval of Attachment 5 to MS633 which acknowledges an increase of disturbance by 0.06 ha to the Southern Mines and Processing Development Envelope under changes to the Ministerial statement and reflected in the figures provide.
- The removal of reference to windfarms is reflected in the documentation of the assessment for Attachment 5 which states that insufficient baseline data was provided for approval via a s.45C application.

EFFECT OF THIS NOTICE:

1. The proposal as amended in accordance with this notice is taken to be able to be implemented under s. 45 of the EP Act.

RIGHTS OF APPEAL:

There are no rights of appeal under the EP Act in respect of this decision.
