			Condition 8-3(1) of MS 812 requiring the proponent to monitor ambient air quality is no longer required as dust monitoring is undertaken by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER). Control of the dust monitoring network was transferred to DWER in January 2022. Removal of conditions relating to dust monitoring is not expected to result in a significant effect on the environmental factor of Social Surroundings.
