## Preliminary

**Environmental Factors:** Flora and Vegetation, Terrestrial Fauna, Amenity, Heritage, Offsets, Rehabilitation and Decommissioning.

**Potential Significant Effects:** Flora and Vegetation - clearing of good to excellent vegetation. Terrestrial Fauna - loss of habitat for all three black cockatoos species. Amenity - loss of amenity due to noise and/or dust. Rehabilitation and Decommissioning - unsuccessful rehabilitation may impede inclusion of reserve into Serpentine National Park.

**Determination: Assess: Public Environmental Review (Assessment No. 2084) with 4 weeks public review and proponent prepared scoping document.**
