Explanation of decision:

Request from the Minister for Environment to inquire into how implementation conditions relating to approved waste to energy proposals should be changed to restrict the waste feedstock to genuinely residual waste in accordance with waste hierarchy under section 5 of the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Act 2007*.
