Potential significant effects:

The proposal includes up to 5,000 hectares of disturbance consisting of: 2,000 ha of disturbance to the lake surface, and 3,000 ha of land-based disturbance.

Clearing of native vegetation which is also potential habitat for conservation significant fauna species; impact to fauna and habitat due to development of lake-based operations on the lake playa; changes to hydrological and hydrogeological regimes due to development on the lake surface; inundation of the riparian zone and changes in water and sediment quality due to dewatering discharge to the lake; impact to surface water movement on the land and lake surfaces due to land clearing and mine related development.

Preliminary key environmental factors:

Flora and Vegetation, Terrestrial Fauna, Subterranean Fauna, Hydrological Processes, and Inland Waters Environmental Quality.
