Potential significant effects:

The development envelope covers an area of 52.66 ha and consists of the following land and marine elements There are potential impacts to flora and vegetation and terrestrial fauna from the clearing of up to 34.23 ha of native vegetation within the development envelope. There will be a direct loss of up to 6.18 ha of benthic habitat from the construction of a new wharf. A temporary reduction in water quality during wharf construction may occur. Increased vessel movements may impact on marine fauna.
