Potential significant effects:

Clearing and disturbance of up to 70.2 ha of native vegetation, including 1.1 ha of a Threatened Ecological Community (the Melaleuca huegelii – M. acerosa (M. systena) shrublands on limestone ridges), conservation significant fauna species, loss of a portion of the Alkimos Dune System, impacts from noise and vibration.

Level of assessment: Referral Information with Additional Information (4 week public review)

Explanation of decision: Several preliminary key environmental factors are complex. The proponent has generally provided adequate referral information about the proposal, the environmental values of the area and the potential impacts of the proposal. However, additional information is required to further assess the proposal including: clarifying impacts to subterranean and short-range endemic fauna; environmental management measures and/or plans for the key environmental factors; and environmental offsets for the potentially significant residual impacts.
