There are potential impacts on: Flora and Vegetation and Terrestrial Fauna from clearing of 1400 hectares of native vegetation off the lake surface and in access corridors which will impact on; Inland Waters, Flora and Vegetation and Terrestrial Fauna from disturbance of up to 10,000 hectares of the surface of Lake Mackay for the construction of trenches and evaporation ponds to extract 70 gigalitres per annum (GL/a) of brine; Subterranean Fauna from abstraction of up to 5 GL/a of water for a fresh water supply; Social Surroundings due to the presence of Aboriginal heritage sites in the development envelope and proximity of the proposal to local communities.
