Impacts on flora, vegetation, and terrestrial fauna from the clearing of native vegetation, potential impacts to Aboriginal heritage sites during clearing and construction, potential impacts of air emissions on nearby rock art and public health, and impact on marine environmental quality from the discharge of wastewater into King Bay via the Water Corporation Multi-User Brine Return Line, impacts on tidal flats from the construction of a link between Sites C and F.

Coastal Processes, Marine Environmental Quality, Flora and Vegetation, Terrestrial Fauna, Air Quality, and Social Surroundings.
