Additional information required will include:

- the results from a small scale trial to be designed with the concurrence of the
 Department of Water and Environmental Regulation and Department of Primary
 Industries and Regional Development. The purpose of the trial is to increase
 confidence in predicted nutrient export rates from the proposal; and
- A revised Nutrient and Irrigation Management Plan to be informed by the trial.

Explanation of decision:

The proposal has two preliminary key environmental factors which require additional information and further assessment to determine the extent of the proposal's potential impacts, and how the environmental issues could be managed to meet the nutrient targets of the Environmental Protection (Peel Inlet - Harvey Estuary) Policy 1992 and Murray Drainage and Water Management Plan 2011.
