There are potential impacts on: Flora and Vegetation from the clearing of an additional 5995 ha of native vegetation; Terrestrial Fauna from the clearing of habitat and indirect impacts on Fortescue Marsh which contains significant fauna habitat, Inland Waters from increased dewatering and the Managed Aquifer Recharge scheme; Subterranean Fauna from dewatering of the pit and Managed Aquifer Recharge; Air Quality from the increased emissions.

Preliminary key environmental factors: Flora and Vegetation, Subterranean Fauna, Terrestrial Fauna, Inland Waters, Air Quality
