There are potential impact on: Flora and Vegetation from the clearing of 398 ha, including several small populations of Priority 4 flora. Terrestrial Fauna from the clearing of foraging habitat and from disturbance of bat roosts, including the direct loss of 2 diurnal roosts and risk of indirect impacts from noise, vibration and humidity changes to breeding roosts.
