Potential significant effects:

There are potential impacts to Social Surroundings from construction and operation noise, dust, vibration and visual amenity, Inland Waters from changes in hydrological regimes, hydrocarbon spills and erosion, Flora and Vegetation from the spread of weeds or dieback, Terrestrial Fauna from vehicle strikes and indirect impacts to fauna habitat, Landforms from the disturbance of 26 ha of the Yalgorup Plain formation.

Referral Information with additional information required under section 40(2)(a) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (2 week public review).

Explanation of decision:

Assessment is required to determine the extent of the proposal's direct and indirect impacts to Social Surroundings, and how these impacts will be managed. Preliminary investigations of Inland Waters, Flora and Vegetation, Terrestrial Fauna and Landforms determined the impacts to these environmental factors are not likely to be significant. Advice on surface and groundwater was provided by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation. No native vegetation or fauna habitat will be cleared for the proposal and the proposed mitigation measures to prevent indirect impacts to offsite vegetation and fauna are considered sufficient. The scale of the impact to the Yalgorup Plain is considered small, with a large extent of the Yalgorup Plain protected in conservation estate.
