Potential significant effects: Potential impacts to marine fauna (marine turtles) from the additional artificial light, inland waters and subterranean fauna from the abstraction of groundwater and nutrient enrichment from the use of treated wastewater for irrigation, to flora and vegetation and terrestrial fauna from the clearing of up to 4.52 ha of native vegetation, and social surroundings, including from potential disturbance of Aboriginal sites.

Consultation and engagement with Traditional Owners is also required.
