**Proposal title:** Tonkin Highway Grade Separated Interchanges Kelvin Road

**Proposal location:** Primarily in the City of Gosnells from one kilometre north of Kelvin Road in the suburbs of Kenwick and Wattle Grove (City of Kalamunda) to Maddington Road in the suburbs of Maddington and Orange Grove.

**Potential significant effects:**

There are potential impacts on: **Flora and Vegetation** from the clearing and disturbance of 10.6 ha, including of significant flora and vegetation; **Terrestrial Fauna** from the clearing of habitat important to significant species; and **Inland Waters** from clearing and disturbance, and changes to hydrological regimes and water quality.

**Preliminary key environmental factors:** Flora and Vegetation, Terrestrial Fauna, Inland Waters.

**Explanation of decision:**

Detailed assessment is required to determine the extent of the proposal's direct and indirect impacts, and whether the EPA's environmental factor objectives can be met. At referral, the proponent provided substantial information for assessment such that the EPA considers that the assessment can be undertaken on Referral Information with additional information. Additional information is required regarding impacts to Flora and Vegetation, Terrestrial Fauna and Inland Waters.

**Appeals:** Decision not appealable.
