There are potential impacts on: flora and vegetation from the clearing of 390 ha; terrestrial fauna from the clearing of habitat and fauna strikes; air quality from the discharge of atmospheric pollutants; the environment as greenhouse gas emissions will exceed 100,000 tonnes of $\mathrm{CO}_{2}$-e per annum; and social surroundings from construction and operation noise, dust and odour emissions, and potential impacts to Aboriginal cultural heritage values.
