Potential significant effects:

There are potential impacts on: **flora and vegetation** from the clearing of up to 7,406 hectares (ha); **terrestrial fauna** from the clearing of habitat, and fauna strikes; **subterranean fauna** from resource extraction and mine dewatering resulting in loss of habitat; **terrestrial environmental quality** from disturbance of soil structure and potential discharge resulting in changes to quality; **inland waters** from groundwater abstraction and the potential for alteration of hydrological regimes; **air quality** from excavation, crushing, screening and transport of bulk materials, including potential disturbance of asbestiform minerals; **greenhouse gas emissions** and the potential to exceed 100,000 tCO₂-e per annum; **social surroundings** from construction and operation noise, dust emissions and potential impacts to Aboriginal cultural heritage values; **benthic communities and habitats, coastal processes, marine environmental quality,** and **marine fauna** from construction and changes in quality associated with implementation of the proposal in the marine environment.

Preliminary key environmental factors: benthic communities and habitat, coastal processes, marine environmental quality, marine fauna, flora and vegetation, subterranean fauna, terrestrial environmental quality, terrestrial fauna, inland waters, air quality, greenhouse gas emissions, and social surroundings.
