### **Potential significant effects:**

There are potential impacts on: flora and vegetation from the clearing of 1,885 ha of native vegetation; terrestrial fauna from the clearing of habitat; inland waters due to discharge of mine waste and diversion of surface water; terrestrial environmental quality from potential contamination sources; Greenhouse gas emissions from construction and operations; and social surroundings from disturbance of Aboriginal cultural heritage values.

**Preliminary key environmental factors:** flora and vegetation, terrestrial environmental quality, terrestrial fauna, inland waters, greenhouse gas emissions and social surroundings.
