**Potential significant effects:**

There are potential impacts on: greenhouse gas emissions from the potential to exceed 100,000 tCO<sub>2</sub>-e per annum; social surroundings from the potential impacts to Aboriginal and European heritage sites and noise emissions; air quality from impacts of emissions; flora and vegetation from potential cumulative impacts to vegetation; terrestrial fauna from impacts on black cockatoo foraging habitat and potential cumulative impacts to fauna habitat; marine environmental quality from the potential impacts of treated waste water and unplanned discharges; inland waters from the potential impacts from dewatering and spills and leaks.

**Preliminary key environmental factors:** greenhouse gas emissions, social surroundings, air quality, flora and vegetation, terrestrial fauna, marine environmental quality, and inland waters.
