PROPOSED QUEENSLAND FRUITFLY ERADICATION PROGRAMME

DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

This proposal may be implemented subject to the following conditions:

1. The proponent shall adhere to the proposal as assessed by the Environmental Protection Authority and shall fulfill the commitments made in the Notice of Intent (copy of Notice of Intent attached).
2. The proponent shall submit reports to the Environmental Protection Authority at two-monthly intervals during the active phase of the programme in a form suitable for public release, on the results of monitoring the programme, including:
 - . the effectiveness of the programme in eradicating Queensland Fruitfly; and
 - . any adverse impacts of the programme on the environment and proposals for their amelioration.
