STATEMENT TO AMEND CONDITIONS APPLYING TO A PROPOSAL (PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 46 OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1986)

PROPOSAL:

LIMESAND EXTRACTION, LANCELIN (578)

CURRENT PROPONENT: WESTDEEN HOLDINGS PTY LIMITED

CONDITIONS SET ON: 5 NOVEMBER 1987

Conditions 1, 2, and 3 have been amended to read as follows:

- 1. The proponent shall not mine more than 40 000 tonnes of material over the five year period from 1988 to 1992 inclusive.
- 2. The proponent shall refer any proposal for extraction of material in excess of the cumulative 40 000 tonnes for the specified period or for continued operations beyond 31 December 1992, to the Environmental Protection Authority.
- 3. The proponent shall carry out operations and measures to protect the environment in accordance with the proposals outlined in the documents entitled "Endeavour Resources Limited, Mining Plan for Mining Tenements at Lancelin" dated August 1987 and "Westdeen Holdings Pty Ltd, Limesand mining Lancelin, Approval to increase tonnes mined" dated November 1990.

The following condition is inserted following condition 3:

4. No transfer of ownership, control or management of the project which would give rise to a need for the replacement of the proponent shall take place until the Minister for the Environment has advised the proponent that approval has been given for the nomination of a replacement proponent. Any request for the exercise of that power of the Minister shall be accompanied by a copy of this statement endorsed with an undertaking by the proposed replacement proponent to carry out the project in accordance with the conditions and procedures set out in the statement.

Procedure

Any referral by the proponent to the Environmental Protection Authority required by condition 2 will also be referred to the Department of Mines.
