Pursuant to section 45 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*, as applied by section 46(8), it has been agreed that the implementation conditions set out in Ministerial Statement No. 976 as amended by Ministerial Statement 1092, be changed as specified in this Statement.

Condition 3 of Ministerial Statement 976 is deleted and replaced with:

3 Time Limit for Proposal Implementation

3-1 The proponent shall not commence implementation of the proposal after 9 July 2024, and any commencement, prior to this date, must be substantial.

3-2 Any commencement of implementation of the proposal, on or before 9 July 2024, must be demonstrated as substantial by providing the CEO with written evidence, on or before 9 July 2024.



1. Proposal description is deleted and replaced with:

The proposal is to construct and operate a facility within the existing Red Hill Waste Management Facility, City of Swan, for the processing of waste using aerobic composting technology and/or for the processing of waste to produce energy using anaerobic digestion technology.

2. Condition 3 is deleted and replaced with:

3 Time Limit for Proposal Implementation

3-1 The proposal must be substantially commenced within five (5) years from the date of this Notice.

3-2 The proponent must provide to the CEO documentary evidence demonstrating that they have complied with condition 3-1 no later than fourteen (14) days after the expiration of period specified in condition 3-1.

3-3 If the proposal has not been substantially commenced within the period specified in condition 3-1, implementation of the proposal must not be commenced or continued after the expiration of that period.
