DECISION

Pursuant to s. 45C (1) (a) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act), the Chair acting as delegate for the Minister for Environment gives approval to the following amendments of the approved proposal:

- Relocation of Garden Organics (GO) processing area from Lot 12 to an existing cleared area in Lots 9 and 10
- Inclusion of Part Lots 8, 9 and 10 into the authorised extent of Ministerial Statement 274
- Increase in GO processing area from 3.5 ha to 4.4 ha.

The new Attachment to Ministerial Statement 274 is attached.

SUMMARY OF REASONS

- The proposed amendments will result in minor changes to the configuration of the development envelope due to the relocation of the GO processing area.
- The proposed amendments will not result in changes to the amount of GO material processed, the processing technology employed (aerobic composting) or the testing protocol, and are not likely to result in any significant effect on the environment.

- The existing GO processing area will be decommissioned and relocated to existing cleared areas on Lots 9 and 10 and will be further away from sensitive receptors, reducing potential noise, dust and odour impacts.
- There are no new environmental factors likely to be significantly affected as a result of the amendments.
- The effects of the amendments on their own, the effect of the amendments in the context of the existing referred proposal, cumulative impacts, and holistic impacts have been considered.
- The amended proposal will be substantially the same character as the existing referred proposal.

EFFECT OF THIS NOTICE:

1. The proposal as amended in accordance with this notice is taken to be able to be implemented under s. 45 of the EP Act.

RIGHTS OF APPEAL:

There are no rights of appeal under the EP Act in respect of this decision.
