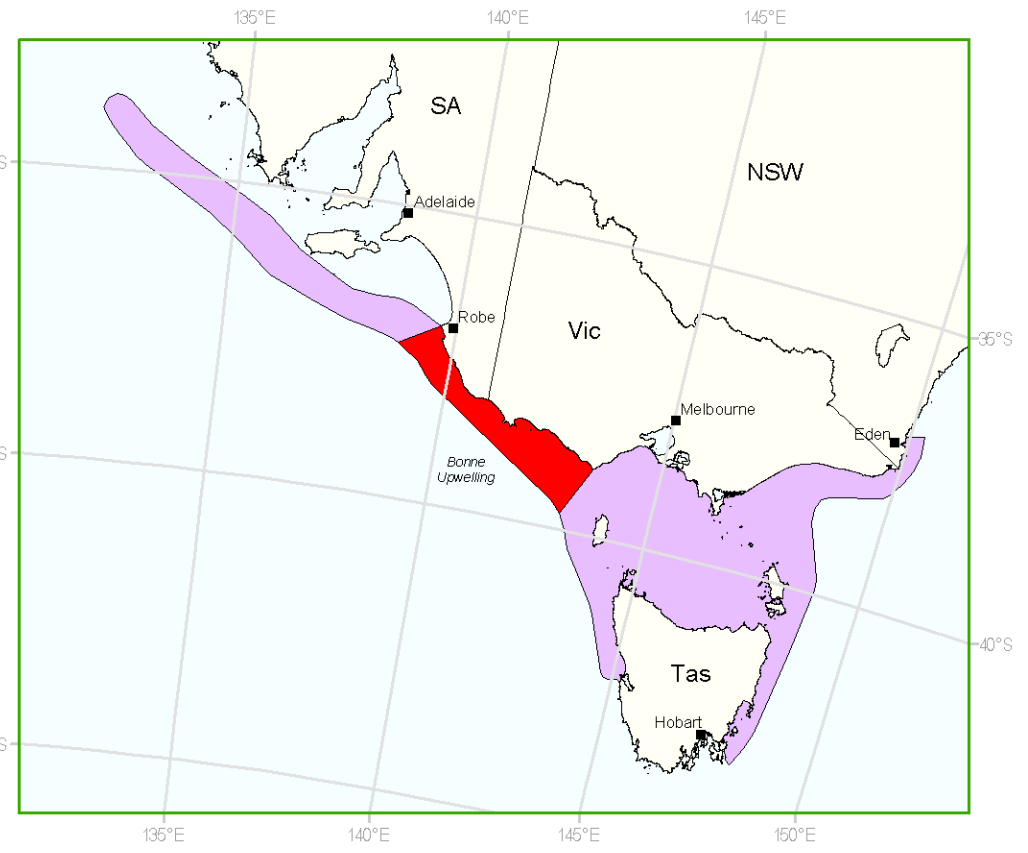
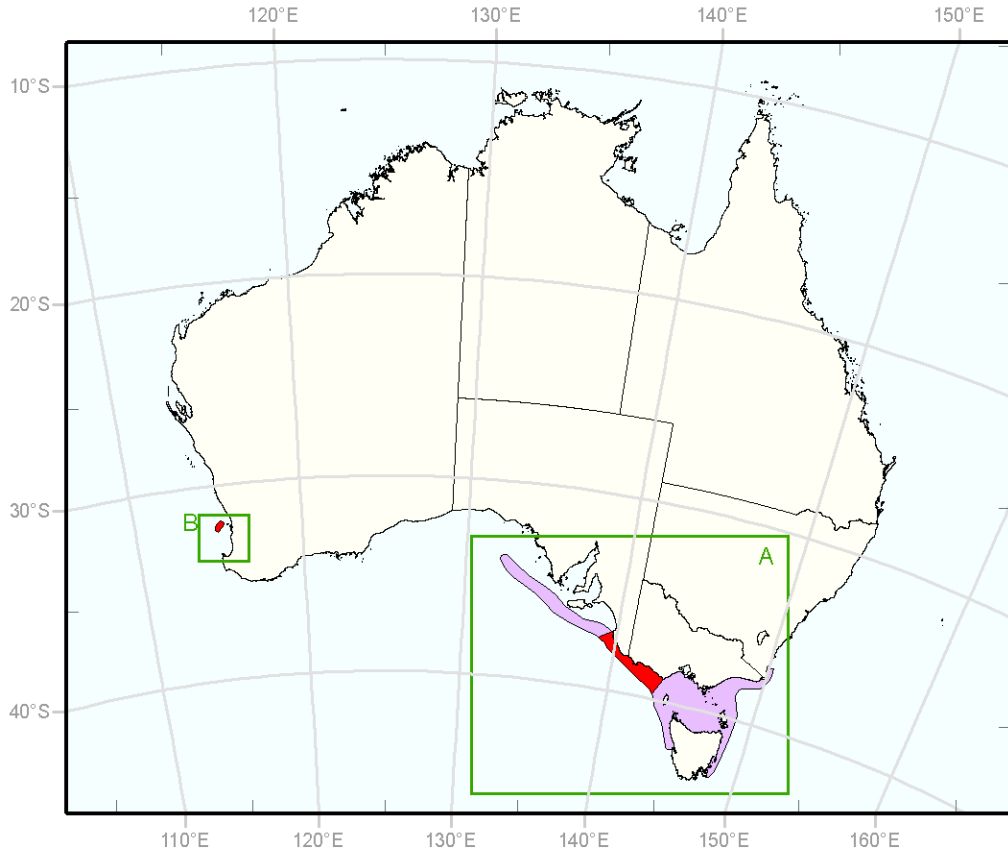
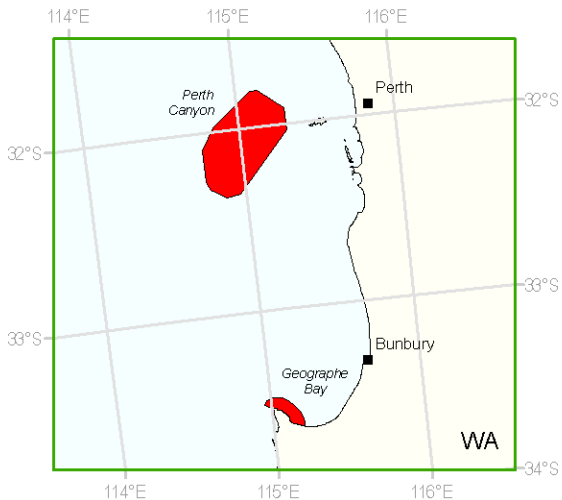


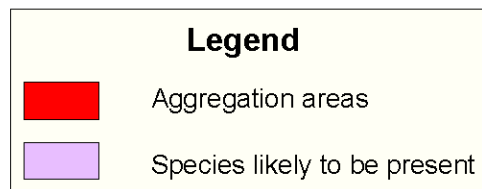
Figure 1: Recognised aggregation areas of the blue whale

Figure 1: Distribution and recognised aggregation areas of the southern right whale

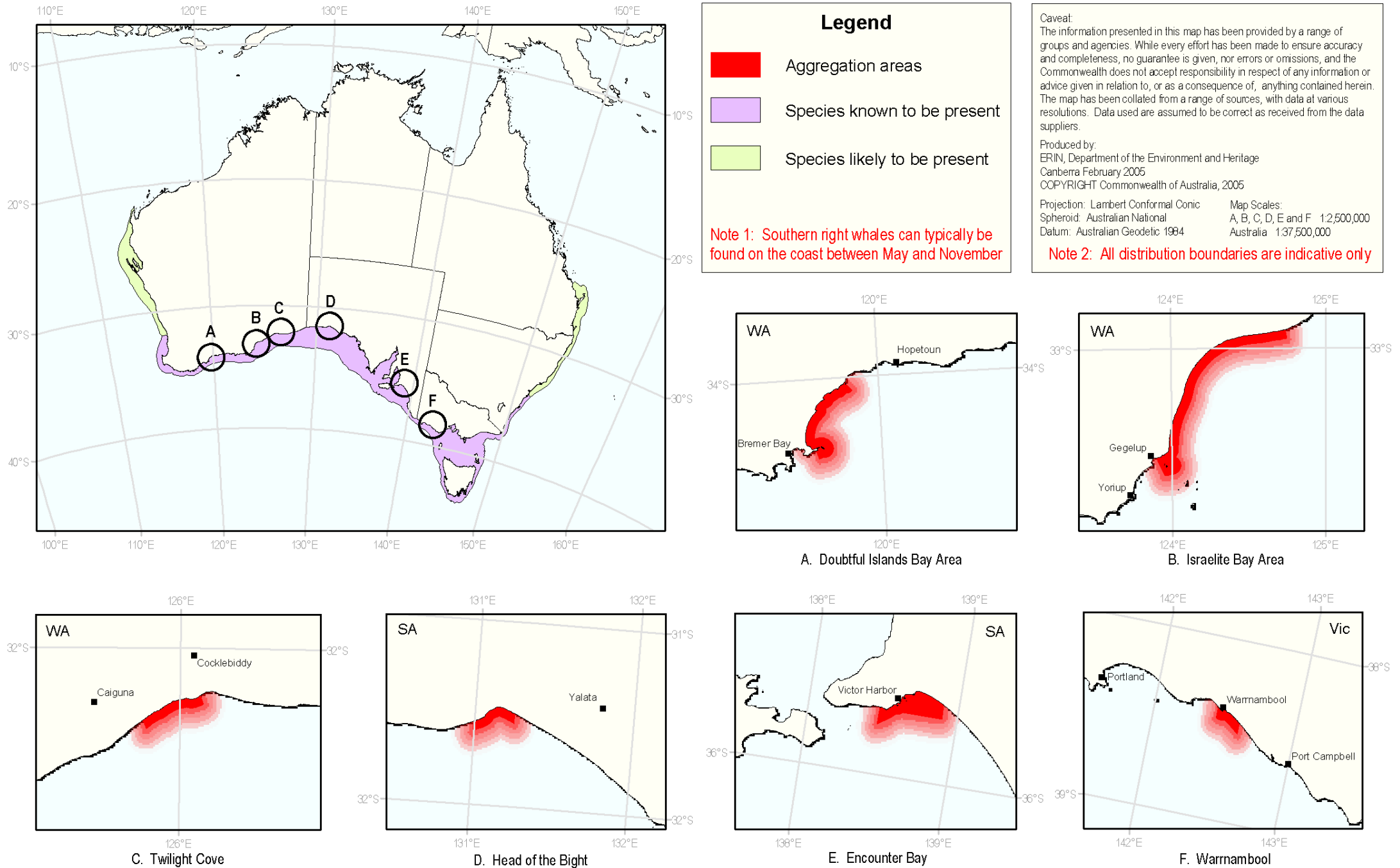


Figure 1: Distribution, migration and recognised aggregation areas of the humpback whale
