PROPOSED CLOSURE OF GOULDEN RD TO SUPPORT A MINING PROJECT - 'YOONGARILLUP'

Thank you for your correspondence seeking support from the City to close two sections of Goulden Road, so that the road land may form part of the 'Yoongarillup' mining project.

At this stage, the City does not object to Doral Mineral Sands making a formal request to close the two sections of Goulden Road as proposed, for a set period of time. Please note that a proposal to close the road would require a decision of the Council in accordance with the *Local Government Act 1995*.

In the request for the temporary road closures, please provide further information on the following:

- the expected road closure date and duration;
- the impact of the road closures on road traffic;
- the amount of any proposed clearing from the road land, and the type of vegetation affected;
- any letters of support or objection from adjoining land owners for the project;
- the route of haulage vehicles to and from the mining operation; and
- how Doral Mineral Sands would propose to reinstate road and vegetation after the mining operation.

Please note that the 2013/14 scheduled fee for road closure proposals is \$662. This may change for the new financial year.

DORAL MINERAL SANDS - YOONGARILLUP PROJECT - PROPOSAL TO RELOCATE SUES ROAD.

I refer to your email of 29 January 2014 and recent discussions in regard to the proposed temporary realignment of the section of Sues Road which passes through Mining Lease area M70/0459 at Yoongarillup to provide access to the mineral resource within the existing road reserve.

Main Roads has no objection in principle to the proposal, however, prior to final approval being granted agreement will need to be reached on a range of issues including the following;

- o The design and construction of the temporary detour.
- The timing for reinstatement of Sues Road on its current alignment noting that this should be done as soon as practically possible.
- Methodology and controls for backfilling under the existing road after it has been mined.
- o Rehabilitation of the road verge area.
- Setbacks for mining activity.

The agreement reached will need to be documented in a formal Deed of Agreement and will need to be backed by a Bank Guarantee or similar surety with a value that reflects the risk to Main Roads of allowing the road reserve to be mined in this way.

Also, Doral will be required to meet all Main Roads costs associated with this proposal.
