NOTICE OF DECISION TO CONSENT TO CHANGE TO PROPOSAL DURING ASSESSMENT

PROPOSAL TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES:

Great Southern Landfill at Alluwuna Farm Lots 4869, 5931, 9926 and 26934 Great Southern Highway, St Ronans Assessment No. 2204

Pursuant to section 43A of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act), the Environmental Protection Authority consents to the proponent making the following changes to the proposal during assessment without a revised proposal being referred:




Figure 1: Great Southern Landfill at Allawuna Farm Development Envelope and Indicative Footprint

- 1. Modification of the development envelope and disturbance footprint to incorporate intersection upgrades to Great Southern Highway, resulting in a decrease in development envelope by 1,374 hectares (ha), an increase in the disturbance footprint by 7.61 ha and a reduction in native vegetation clearing by 44 ha as defined in Table 2 and Figure 1 below.
- 2. Change of proposal name to 'Great Southern Landfill at Allawuna Farm, Great Southern Highway, St. Ronans' to reflect the actual proposal development envelope and to simplify the name of the proposal.

EFFECT OF THIS NOTICE:

The EPA considers that the change is unlikely to significantly increase any impact the proposal may have on the environment and therefore the proponent may change the proposal as provided for in this notice.
