A number of sites have been considered and Alkimos is well places to service the growing norther suburbs while providing an appropriate volume of land and access to the coast.</p> <p>Concept planning for the possible plant has lowered the site into the dunes to reduce visibility from the surrounding residential properties (future homes are very unlikely to be able to see the plant). Lowering the buildings into the dunes will reduce light spill and support containing light within the property.
