AGRIMIN LIMITED - MACKAY POTASH PROJECT - ENGAGEMENT WITH PARNA NGURURRPA (ABORIGINAL CORPORATION) RNTBC

- 1. Parna Ngururrpa (Aboriginal Corporation) RNTBC (PNAC) writes this letter to Agrimin Limited ("Agrimin" or "the Company") and its associated subsidiary companies, to acknowledge the Company's ongoing engagement with the Ngururrpa Native Title Holders over the past two years with regard to the haul road component of the Mackay Sulphate of Potash Project (Project). The Company has kept PNAC informed of the Project's progress to date.
- 2. This letter is provided to the Company to acknowledge the positive dialogue and consultations that Agrimin have had with PNAC in relation to the development of the Project to date.
- 3. PNAC acknowledges the impact caused by the COVID-19 pandemic on the parties' ability to progress some of the planned negotiations they had intended to undertake this year. As a result, PNAC understands that the Company's timelines have been impacted.
- 4. Today in Broome, PNAC commenced negotiations in relation to the Project with the company. PNAC notes at this stage however, it has not provided its consent for the construction of the Project.
- 5. PNAC looks forward to continuing to participate in meaningful negotiations and discussions with Agrimin and continuing to develop a positive working relationship between the parties as the Project progresses, and continue to work towards an agreement.
