- Demonstrate visible environmental commitment and leadership
- Ensure that all our operations comply with environmental laws, regulations and commitments
- Regularly audit and report on Reward’s environmental performance and continually strive to improve that environmental performance
- Develop environmental awareness and knowledge of this policy amongst our employees through education and training
- Provide adequate resources to enable effective implementation of this policy and the supporting Lake Disappointment Conservation Management Plan
- Ensure that environmental risks are systematically identified and recorded and that adequate controls are implemented to mitigate and manage those risks
- Thoroughly investigate and report all serious environmental incidents

Reward’s employees, consultants, contractors, service providers and visitors are required to:

- Attend an environmental induction prior to commencing to work with Reward or visit a Company site
- Comply with all applicable environmental laws, regulations and commitments relevant to its operations
- Understand and comply with the requirements of the Lake Disappointment Conservation Management Plan in their area of work
- Seek to prevent, control or mitigate potential environmental impacts in their work area
- Report all environmental hazards, incidents and near misses to their respective supervisors as soon as possible.
