Dear Anna

Jonathon Majer refers to Plavins as the name of one of the forest blocks sampled for ants using pitfall traps near Dwellingup (see [https://espace.curtin.edu.au/bitstream/handle/20.500.11937/17407/19125\\_downloaded\\_stream\\_217.pdf?sequence=2](https://espace.curtin.edu.au/bitstream/handle/20.500.11937/17407/19125_downloaded_stream_217.pdf?sequence=2)).

Steve Curry referred to "Plavins plots" on the labels that were on the samples that were given to WAM in the 1970s. My understanding is that pitfall traps would be set out for surveys of invertebrates in the jarrah forest around Dwellingup and it seems that the Plavins forest coupe was the area Curry was surveying.

Aname 'dwellingup' is a registered specimen and there is no indication that it is not in the collection. It is a male according to our records. The male specimen was identified as *Aname* sp. 'dwellingup' by Dr Barbara Main in 1993, but the vial cannot currently be located in the collection of the WA Museum. This is most likely because it is within one of several large jars of unidentified *Aname* specimens. Barbara Main's identifiers from this period have often been found to be suspect, and the WA Museum does not currently recognise the informal name *Aname* sp. 'dwellingup' until the specimen can be located and reidentified.

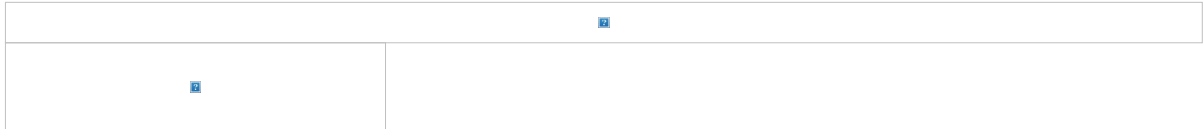

As you know, we have done some rather large surveys in the Northern Jarrah Forests over the last few years. We are currently mid-way through another.

One of the responses from DWER regarding South32' Worsley Mine Expansion ERD relate to the many unresolved species from our survey. 532 have asked us to try and resolve these as far as we can using molecular techniques. I have submitted many of these to you already, I have attached a list of these species and their associated WAM T registration numbers and I would like to come in at your earliest convenience to sub-sample.

I know there's a lot to get through, if it helps I can go through the jars and fish them out? and there are some I will require splitting...

There are a couple that don't have T-numbers and I not sure if these have been submitted - I can't find anything in my inbox regarding submitting these, and Erich identified some of them. Are you able to do a quick check of the PES numbers though in case I forgot to add the WAM T numbers to our database? If not I guess they are somewhere here or still with Erich.
