| Short description | Austral Bricks is proposing the redevelopment of the Cardup Brickworks which includes the expansion of the existing factory increasing the design capacity from 200,000 to 250,000 tonnes per annum, with an estimated actual throughput of 230,000 tonnes per annum. Additional ancillary improvements include the installation of a new baghouse scrubber and a new primary crusher located in the floor of the pit. |
