

## NOISE MANAGEMENT STATEMENT

An Extractive Industry development application has been prepared by Harley Dykstra on behalf of Ietto Farms Pty Ltd for an extractive industry over a portion of Lots 1498 and 1504, Finn Road, Myalup.

Ietto Farms owner, Mr John Ietto, wishes to gain approval to continue to extract limestone and sand from the site for the main purpose of road construction projects throughout the south west of the state.

APH Contractors have been operating the pit on behalf of the licensee and landowner (Mr John Ietto – Ietto Farms Pty Ltd) for approximately ten years.

The site is approximately 11km north of Myalup townsite and 13km south of Preston Beach townsite in the locality of Parkfield as shown in Figure 1 – Locality Plan. It is surrounded by Lake Preston to the west and mainly farming land used for grazing and market gardens. Other extractive industries are in the area.

No formal Noise Assessment has been undertaken as part of this license application due to no sensitive landuses being located within a 500m radius of the extraction site. The closest existing dwelling on Lot 19, Hazlett Road is located approximately 700m north east of the extraction area.

Prevailing winds are moderate easterly breezes in the mornings are replaced in the afternoons by westerly sea breezes.

Noise impacts from the excavation are minimal as operations are of a minor nature and are generally only in operation 2 to 3 days per week during normal working hours.

The site has been in operation for over 10 years and during this period, no noise complaints have been received.

Therefore, given the relative minimal impact proposed to surrounding sensitive landuses, no detailed noise assessment has been completed.

Notwithstanding the above, to ensure noise generated onsite does not cause any adverse impact on surrounding landowners, mitigation measures such as well maintained machinery and not allowing idling vehicles/trucks to be left running when not necessary will be practised. The following table details the noise mitigation measures and appropriate actions.

The objective of this statement is to recognise that noise levels continue to be at an acceptable level and to ensure no complaints are received from surrounding landowners, the Shire of Harvey or environmental agencies.

The operator of the extractive site, APH Contractors, is an experienced and well established civil contractor being in business over 30 years in the South West. All complaints received by APH employees in relation to site works will be handled in accordance with APH's Incident and Complaint's Procedure, including completion of the Complaints Register and Incident Investigation report.
