What is the current land use on the property, and the extent (area in hectares) of the property?	The current land use within and adjacent to the Development Envelope is pastoralism. The Development Envelope is located within the Blina pastoral station (~254,600 ha) and the Noonkanbah pastoral station (~172,400 ha). The Proposal comprises a disturbance footprint of approximately 109 ha within the Development Envelope (~93,007 ha). This area is associated with ten well sites, access tracks and camp facilities. Although well site locations at the time of writing the Proposal are accurate, it is expected that once additional data is gathered and interpreted, these well locations may be further optimised within the Development Envelope. Refer to Section 5.5.3.2 of the Supplementary Information Document.
