Title: Shire of Exmouth Local Planning Scheme No.4 Amendment No.6

Location: Various lots which are vested as either Shire and/or Crown land in the Shire of Exmouth.

Description: Amendment 6 proposes to insert the new definition 'Major Event' temporarily (two weeks either

side of the Solar Eclipse event) into both section 2.3 'Additional uses in Local Reserves' (AR1) and

into Schedule 2 – 'Additional Uses (A9)'.

This will enable the Shire to cater for/accommodate the expected tourist numbers resulting from

the Total Solar Eclipse in April 2023.

approval scheme text. Clearing permit applications are required unless exempt. The EPA supports avoidance of clearing for temporary

development.
