Preliminary Environmental Factors: Flora and vegetation and Terrestrial fauna

Potential Significant Effects: Implementation of the amendment may result in the clearing of

remnant vegetation potentially representative of the Banksia Woodlands of the Swan Coastal Plain ecological community, and

habitat for threatened species of black cockatoo.

Protection: Potential impacts can be managed through existing scheme

provisions and future planning processes. The Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) advice has been provided on matters including that flora and vegetation and fauna (black cockatoo habitat) surveys. The EPA expects that the outcomes of these surveys will

guide and inform the future planning process.

Determination: Referral Examined, Preliminary Investigations and Inquiries
