### PROPOSAL TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES:

Learmonth Pipeline Fabrication Facility Assessment No. 2208

At the request of Subsea 7 Australia Contracting Pty Ltd (in its letter of 4 January 2021) and pursuant to s40A of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act), the Environmental Protection Authority has decided to terminate the assessment of the Proposal.
