PROPOSAL TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES:

Proposal Title: Coastal Walk Trail from Point Ann to Hamersley Inlet - Fitzgerald River National Park Assessment No: 1885 Statement No: 884

DECISION

Pursuant to s. 47A of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act), the Executive Director, EPA Services as delegate for the Minister for Environment gives approval for the following:

• Ministerial Statement 884 is withdrawn.

SUMMARY OF REASONS

- The Ministerial Statement has been withdrawn under s. 47A(3)(b) of the EP Act. The impacts of the implementation of the proposal can be satisfactorily mitigated by way of licencing or some other form of regulatory control under this Act or another written law.
- The implementation of the proposal, including the ongoing management of *Phytophthora* dieback, can be satisfactorily mitigated under the *Conservation and Land Management Act 1984* (CALM Act).

The proposal is withdrawn under s. 47A of the EP Act.
