MULGA ROCK URANIUM PROJECT – (ASSESSMENT NO. 1979) – MINOR OR PRELIMINARY WORKS

I refer to your letter dated 7 July 2016 seeking the consent of the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) under section 41A(3) to undertake the works detailed in that letter in relation to the Mulga Rock Uranium Project.

I consider that the proposed works are “minor or preliminary works” within the meaning of section 41A(3) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) and the *Environment Protection Bulletin No. 16: Minor or preliminary works and investigation works*. In particular, I note that the works are reversible should the need arise.

Therefore, as a delegate of the EPA, I consent under section 41A(3) to the following minor or preliminary work being undertaken:

- Clearing of 40ha for the widening of the existing Site Access Road to its full intended final width of 18 metres from approximately 3km from the Tropicana Access Road through to the site of proposed accommodation village (a distance of 29 kilometres). Of this 29km, 22km consists of upgrading the existing single-lane track, whilst 7km of new road will be constructed; and
- Clearing of 30ha for the drilling of 16 production bores located at Kakarook North to a nominal depth of 60 metres.

I advise that the minor or preliminary works for the widening of the existing Site Access Road to its full intended final width of 18 metres from approximately 3km from the Tropicana Access Road through to the site of proposed accommodation village (a distance of 29 kilometres), and drilling the 16 production bores located at Kakarook North to a nominal depth of 60 metres, as detailed by you in your correspondence received 7 July 2016, are authorised under section 41A(3) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

My consent, on behalf of the EPA, to these minor or preliminary works being carried out under section 41A(3) of the EP Act does not remove Vimy Resources Limited's obligations to obtain any other statutory approvals.
