Thank you for referring the above scheme amendment to the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA).

After consideration of the information provided by you, the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) considers that the proposed scheme amendment should not be assessed under Part IV Division 3 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) but nevertheless provides the following advice and recommendations.

The EPA notes the close proximity of the amendment area to the Roebourne Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP). The EPA supports the advice of the Water Corporation that odour sensitive land uses should not be permitted within the industrial zoned land within the WWTP buffer area.

The EPA also supports the proposal to place notification on titles noting that the industrial lots are in proximity to a future residential area and that any land use requiring a buffer as identified in EPA Guidance Statement No. 3 Separation distances between Industrial and Sensitive Land Uses should not intrude into the future residential area.
